

P-51 EMERGENCY EXTRACTION CHECKLIST

This Checklist is specific to this Aircraft

P-51 D N251CS



Aircraft fuel will have 40 to 70 gal. of 100 octane fuel located in left and or right wing fuel tanks.

Aircraft will have 10 gal. of engine oil located forward of the cockpit.

There are no ejection seats or pyrotechnics onboard aircraft.



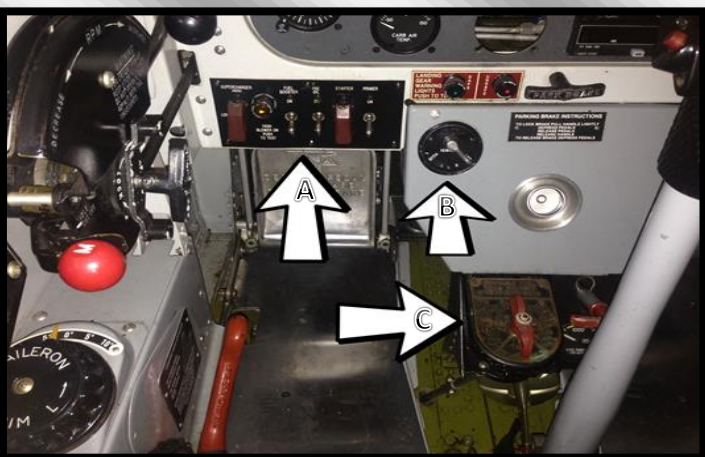
1. To open canopy push red button and hold slide canopy back if that doesn't work (SEE STEP 2)



2. Pull on the aft portion of the bar push on the forward portion of the bar this will release the canopy. (Last resort remove canopy with any means necessary)



3. Squeeze metal tab and pull the red fuel mixture control knob aft this shuts off engine



4. (A) Move all these switches down

(B) Turn magnetos switch to off position

(C) Turn fuel selector off (Arrow will be pointing aft)



5. Move all these switches down



6. Lift up to remove shoulder harness and seat belt (No need to remove parachute, pilot can be lifted up with parachute attached)
