Electrical/Ignition System N229HP



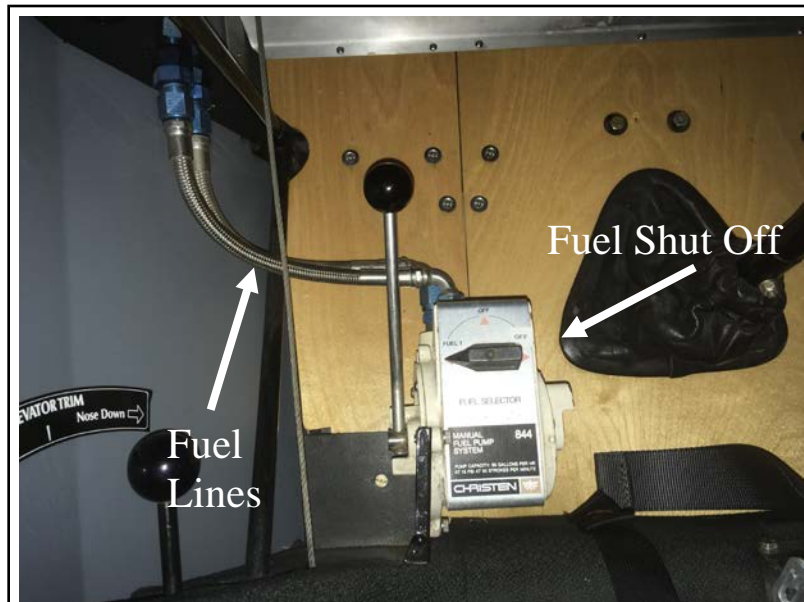
Electrical panel located at pilot's knees.
Key switch to off (rotate to left), and toggle switches to off (down).

Harnesses N229HP



Double lever five point harnesses.
Grey is harness, red is the parachute.

Fuel System N229HP



28 Gallons maximum 100LL fuel tank located between instrument panel and engine firewall.

Fuel shut off is located beneath the pilot's left thigh. Rotate the black lever clockwise to off.

CAUTION: fuel lines run along lower left side of cockpit from fuel shut off to the fuel tank.

6 gallon smoke oil tank located on front cockpit floor.

Pyrotechnics and Ejection Seats N229HP

NO pyro or ejection seats installed

Canopy System N229HP



NORMAL Operation: Rotate handle (fuselage left side) counter clockwise. Then slide canopy aft and lift to hinge up.



CANOPY JETTISON (to be used if **NORMAL** operation will not work). Break through plastic canopy at right side mid-cockpit. Pull red Jettison handle aft. Canopy will disconnect from hinges.
